Inspection will be allowed earlier than posted if inspection team is available. Early Roll Call by appointment. Field committee may have their hounds inspected early.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY:

Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Soughis and Whippets. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC or have been granted an ILP or PAL by the AKC.

FSS Breeds: Effective January 1, 2016: Azawakh, Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande) and Thai Ridgeback 1 year of age or older, that have been recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), or that have been granted and Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) are eligible to enter lure coursing tests and trial for junior, senior and master courser titles but are not eligible for championship points, and are not eligible to run in Best in Field.

Junior Courser & Qualified Courser Test - Hounds must be one year of age or older. QC Test must be passed prior to a dog being allowed to enter the Open Stake.

STAKES OFFERED:

Singles Stake - Hounds are run by themselves, scored, and placements are then determined on the basis of the score.

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or an ASFA Certification Course certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC..

OPEN VETERAN: Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements whose age exceeds six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall exceed five years and Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Afghans, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall exceed seven years.

SPECIAL: Open to all eligible sighthounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points will be awarded from this stake. Qualifying scores earned from the special stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

Note: Hounds who have received a disqualification at an AKC trial are ineligible to compete until recertified.

Note: A hound who has received two dismissals at any time is considered disqualified and will need to meet requalification requirements before competing in competition.

RULES & INFORMATION:

All hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications. Altered or neutered hounds may compete. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are NOT eligible to compete. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Muzzles are not required; it is the owner's responsibility to determine if their hound should be muzzled.

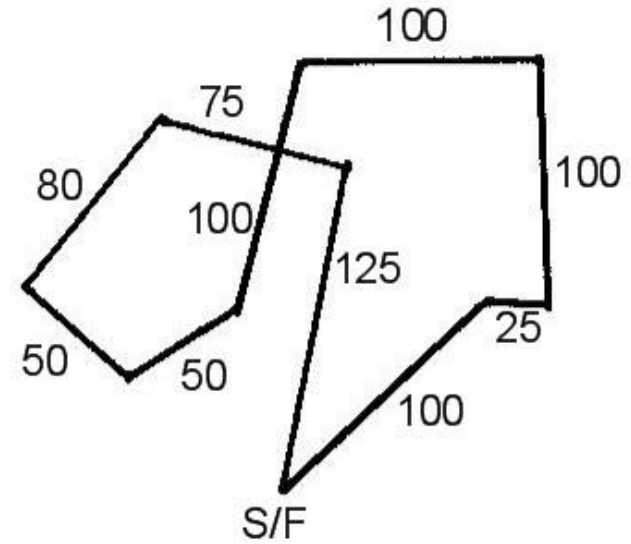
First place Blue ribbon; Second place Red ribbon; Third place Yellow ribbon; Fourth place White ribbon; Fifth place Pink ribbon;

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

BEST IN FIELD WILL BE OFFERED.

All entries must be one year of age or over on the day of the trial.
 Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused.
 Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched.
 Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered.
 A fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for any returned checks.
 There will be a \$5.00 fine for any loose hound on the field that is not part of the course in progress.
 Course will be reversed for finals.
 Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/IWAGS/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site immediately.
 Lure machine is battery powered, continuous loop. Backup equipment is available.
 The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.
 IWAGS reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

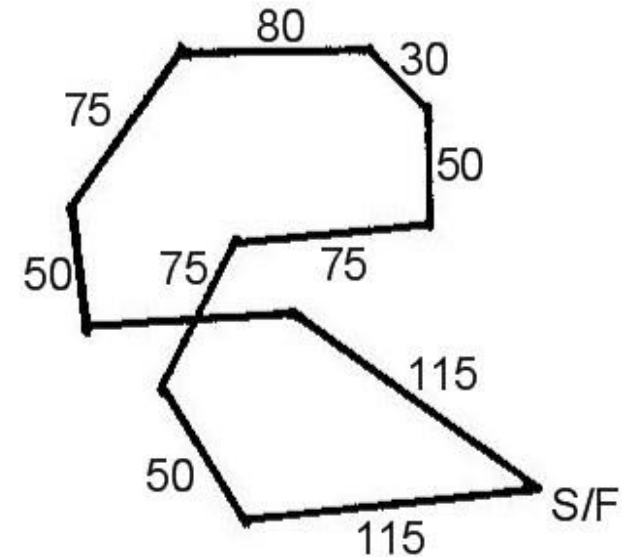
