#### **REGULAR CLASSES**

#### The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

Puppy, 6 Months & Under 9 Months; Puppy, 9 Months & Under 12 Months; 12 to 15 Months; 15 to 18 Months; Novice; Bred-by-Exhibitor; American-Bred; Open; Winners; Best of Breed Competition.

#### **NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES (Involving Single Dog Entries)**

#### **Veteran** — The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

Classes divided: **Bronze** - Six (6) to Eight (8) Years, **Silver** - Eight (8) to Nine (9) Years, **Gold** - Nine (9) years and Older. Winners of the Veteran Classes will compete for Best of Breed and therefore must meet all AKC requirements for Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries.

**Best Head and Best Gait** — Upon completion of Best of Breed, IWAGS offers these Additional Classes. Use the "Additional Classes" box on the entry form to enter.

**Best Dog with Irish Spotting** — Upon completion of Best of Breed, IWAGS offers this Additional Class. Use the "Additional Classes" box on the entry form to enter. Irish spotting is the marking preferred in the country of origin which is white on the feet (all four preferred, but any are eligible), chest, and tip of the tail.

#### NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Upon completion of Best of Breed, IWAGS offers these Additional Classes. As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes. Use the "Additional Classes" box on the entry form to enter.

**Stud Dog** — For Stud Dog and two or more of his Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the Additional Class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

**Brood Bitch** — Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Generations** — To recognize the Breeder who consistently improves upon and breeds quality Irish Wolfhounds. Three generations or more. Primary Entrant must have been bred by the owner. All generations must be <u>direct descendants from the Primary Entrant:</u>

1<sup>st</sup> Generation: Father / Mother

 $2^{\text{nd}}$  Generation: Son / Daughter from the  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  Generation primary entrant.

3<sup>rd</sup> Generation: Son / Daughter from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation entrant.

Subsequent generations not limited to single entries.

The Breeder of the Primary entrant must be the Breeder of either the sire or the dam of each subsequent generation. All dogs must be entered in another regular or non-regular class at this show. Neutered Irish Wolfhounds are eligible for this class. Each dog must have its own handler (does not have to be the owner). The Breeder must be present to accept an award but is not required to handle any entrant.

**Legacy** — To recognize the Breeder(s) who use dogs from history to improve upon the breed and who have had success whelping to the Standard using Frozen Semen by Artificial Insemination (AI).

For two or more Get of a (Deceased) Stud Dog who has not been used more than five (5) times at stud. The Stud Dog must have been deceased at the time of Insemination. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog or the Brood Bitch, but the Get must be whelped from the same Litter. (Same Litter means the same whelp date.) The Get must be entered in one of the regular classes. Each dog must have its own handler (does not have to be the owner). The Breeder of the Get must be present to accept an award but is not required to handle any entrant. Each Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. An 8 X 10 Stacked side view photo of the Sire must be received by the Show Secretary with the AKC entry form and the Legacy entry form before the close of entries.

**Brace** — Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in Brace competition must have at least one common owner.

**Team** — Four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in Team competition must have at least one common owner.
